Marc's fast divorce: What will Jennifer do?

After breaking ties with his estranged wife, Marc Anthony is free to pop the question to Jennifer Lopez

It looks like Jennifer Lopez is one giant step closer to getting a ring from her boyfriend, Marc Anthony. Though rumors of their impending engagement have been circulating for weeks, there's always been a major hurdle for the lovebirds to overcome: Marc was still

married to his estranged wife, Dayanara Torres, 29. But Marc, 34, has cleared away that hurdle — and fast.

Rather than wait for his divorce to make its way through the Florida court system (a process that typically takes a year), the crooner jetted to the Dominican Republic, where couples can get un-hitched in three days.

And it's perfectly legal in the US! "So long as the divorce complies with the rules in this country, it will be recognized here," Florida divorce attorney Wilfred Calero tells *In Touch*.

Dayanara, who had filed for

divorce in Florida five months ago, signed the new papers without hesitation. "It was very, 'Let's end this mess now,'" says a pal of the former Miss Universe, who has two young sons with Marc. "Dayanara wanted that chapter of her life closed before her family affairs were headline news."

Could Marc's quickie divorce put him on the fast track to popping the question? As *In Touch* reported last week, Jennifer and Marc are practically living as husband and wife in LA, where she's shooting *Monster-in-Law* with Jane Fonda. And insiders

claim he can't wait to make La Lopez, 34, his bride.

But is Jennifer ready to accept? After two failed marriages — and the broken Jennifer engagement — she might want to take things more slowly this time around.

Still, friends say Jennifer is the perfect match for Marc, whom she first met more than 10 years ago. "They spend so much time together," says a confidante. "The only thing that would bring their relationship forward would be an engagement."

Now that Marc's marital ties are all but broken, there's nothing in their way.
